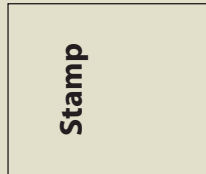

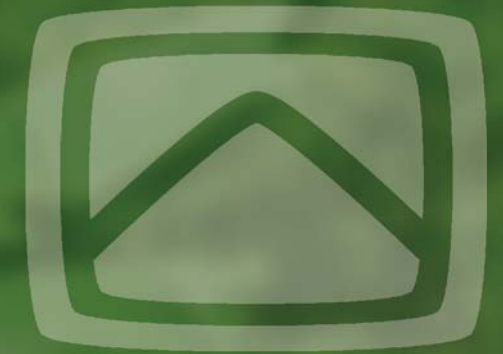

AKAKU: Maui Community Television has been serving the Maui County communities with public, educational and governmental (PEG) access services since 1992. A 501(c)3 nonprofit organization created by the citizens of Maui County and designated by the State of Hawaii Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (DCCA), Akaku provides public access television services and media training to residents from the islands of Maui, Moloka'i, and Lana'i, as well as to air programs about our sister island of Kaho'olawe.

Community access channels, like Akaku: Maui Community Television (Akaku), are venues where community interests are driven at the community level by content-contributors and viewers like you. We reach out to you through the following media:

The Maui Daily is Akaku's community-contributed news magazine program that airs Monday – Friday three times a day on Channel 54.



Akaku.org is our website where we regularly "stream" major news events affecting the Maui community over the internet. Visit Akaku.org to see updates, program schedules, education calendar and more. You can also take advantage of our Video On Demand service by selecting any show you want to air by appointment on Channel 54.

KAKU-LP 88.5 FM is our radio station that airs 24/7 Hawaiian music programming. Sometimes, we inform our listeners of breaking news events in the community via radio. By empowering the community's voice through access to media, Akaku lends strength to the voices of Maui residents in a political climate where freedom of speech is in jeopardy across the country



What we do, Who we are

AKAKU is the voice of Maui Nui! See for yourself!

Production Classes in field, editing and studio are offered year-round to Maui County residents. We have special weeklong programs for youth during seasonal holidays.

Akaku Productions provides professional services and learning opportunities to county government, nonprofits and individuals like you to help produce non-commercial content for air on our cable channels.

A "Hot" Studio awaits you to record your public service announcement, whether you have production experience or not.

The Media Lab gives you access to the industry's latest editing technology with the staff to support your work six days a week.

Akaku: Molokai Media Center is our off-island location that extends these services to Molokai residents—living in one of Hawaii's more rural communities.
